Sub:- Action plan to reduce SPAD cases.

There has been an increase in the number of SPAD cases in the current year. The railway-wise position is as below:-

The above position indicates a lack of effective supervision by the divisional and Zonal level officers. Each and every case of SPAD should be thoroughly investigated so as to arrive at the route cause and to initiate corrective/ preventive action.

Further, a list of all SPAD cases from April'09 - till date is attached. Zonal Railways are requested to update the position regarding D&AR action taken as well as the current status of the action in case it has been reviewed, etc. It may be clearly stated if the employees have been re-instated in any case or not and if so, the job being performed by them.

Zonal Railways should take the following action in SPAD analysis/investigation:

1. The cases of SPAD/accidents on the Zonal Railway should be discussed in the training centers so that there is mass awareness.

- Close monitoring of 10 hr. rule and learning road of the crew should 2. be done. Efforts should be made to minimize the PDD and provide relief crew in case the duty of crew is exceeding the stipulated hours. The Power control and crew controller at the lobby should actively use the CMS for this monitoring.
- The periodical rest of the crew should be monitored and ensured. 3.

Intensive night foot plate by officers/supervisors to be done 4. especially on Goods train.

Increased interaction with the family of crew for bringing about an 5. awareness of the need for proper rest at the home station. working of Welfare Inspectors deputed for each lobby to be closely

monitored.

The condition of running rooms and lobbies to be improved as per 6.

the existing instructions.

Proper feedback mechanism for any unusual incidents reported by 7. the running staff should be implemented similar to what is being done at Pune lobby of Central Railway.

It should be ensured that the running staffs are booked on all the 8.

routes so that their LR does not become overdue.

Running staff should be counseled on the use of mobile phones and 9.

on the alcohol policy.

The officer should test the knowledge of the Inspectors who are 10. engaged in the counseling of the running staff. The Inspectors should be regularly sent for their training courses so that they are conversant with the latest.

The sheds should ensure that all safety items, especially VCDs are 11. functional and the condition of the loco cab mainly the sealing of doors and windows is ensured. Proper cleaning of look out glass, working of wipers and sanders should be ensured before the loco is turned out from shed.
